Prismacolor Colored Pencils

Black

Bronze

Canary Yellow

French Grey 10%, 70%

Sepia

Sharpen new pencils with an electric pencil sharpener. Don't sharpen off the color names!

Additional Supplies

6x8 no. 448 Ivy Mi-Teintes paper

Backboard to support the paper

Crimson Verithin pencil for transferring lines

Scotch Removable Tape

White Graphite

Krylon Workable Fixatif no. 1306

Preparation

Using the Removable tape, tape the line drawing to the textured side of the Mi-Teintes paper. Slip the white graphite between the pattern and the Mi-Teintes paper. Trace over the lines with the Crimson Verithin pencil. The colored lead will show you where you've transferred. After transferring a line, lift the paper to see how heavy the line is transferring; adjust pressure accordingly. Use as fine a line as possible and still be able to see the pattern.
